SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART ONE

1. JURISDICTION:

This event is a National Rally with Foreign Participation, hosted by the Hamilton Car Club and will take place on Saturday 24th November in the King County area.

Leg 1, Rally of Waitomo qualifies as the final round of the Top Half Rally Series.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

Format:

The event is a gravel rally, and will be following the field of the 2018 Silver Fern Rally, as an independent event on:

Saturday 24th November – Rally of Waitomo – (Following Leg 1 of Silver Fern Rally)

3. THE EVENT

Rally of Waitomo Saturday 24th November – (Leg 1 of Silver Fern Rally)

- 3.1 Venue:** The event is a gravel rally starting from Hamilton, heading west towards Raglan, then South to Waitomo for Lunch. After a challenging SS5 and a quick refuel at PioPio, you rally back up through the King Country, then head North to finish back at the Hamilton Car Clubrooms. Plenty of fantastic stages to keep you all on your toes!!
- 3.2 Length:** Comprises of **7 special stages** with an approximate total of **185 km of special stages** and **265 km of touring**.
- 3.3 First Car Starts:** First Rally of Waitomo competitor starts from Claudelands Event Centre, Hamilton at approx. 8.30am, Saturday 24th November 2018.
(Start time to be confirmed in Acceptance of Entry and also published on www.chrissport.nz Friday 23rd November)
- 3.4 First Car Finishes:** First Rally of Waitomo competitor finishes approx. 6.30pm Saturday 24th November at the final control which is situated at the Hamilton Car Clubrooms, 116 Vaile Road, Newstead, Hamilton.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Opening and Closing:** Entries for Rally of Waitomo open on publication of these regulations and close at **5pm Friday 26th October 2018.**

Entries post marked after the normal closing date but received prior to 5.00pm Friday 9th November 2018 may be subject to the late fee.

- 4.2 Entry Acceptance:** Entries shall be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid, must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.3 Fees:

(a) Rally of Waitomo

Entry **\$850.00 inc GST**
Includes Rally Safe

Late entry fee an extra \$150.00 including GST

Service Crews:

Maximum of two service crews allowed. FREE

Refunds:

Any Competitor who withdraws from the event later than 26th of October, but prior to 5pm Friday 9th of November, will forfeit 25% of his or her entry fee.

Any Competitor who withdraws from the event later than 5pm Friday 9th of November, but prior to the commencement of documentation, will forfeit 50% of his or her entry fee.

Any competitor who withdraws after the commencement of documentation will forfeit 100% of his or her entry fee.

4.4 Number of Starters:

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 30 entries are received at normal closing date.

The maximum number of starters will be 50

Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of entry received.

4.5 Acceptance of Entry: (Supplementary Regulations Part Two)

These will be notified Friday 16th November 2018.

Included will be the seeded start list for Rally of Waitomo, Saturday 24th November.

Start List for Rally of Waitomo will be published on Chrisport Friday 23rd November at approx. 7.30pm <http://www.chrisport.nz>

4.6 Competitor Requirements:

(1) Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,

(a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitor's obligations, and

(b) Appendix Three Schedule R articles pertaining to Stage notes, Pace notes and Reconnaissance.

(2) Licence Requirements:

Both the No. 1 and No. 2 drivers shall hold a R1 or R2 Grade or higher MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

(3) New Competitors: Any driver(s) who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the new competitor special briefing.

Rally of Waitomo Leg 1: Friday 23rd November, Approx. 7.15pm Claudelands Event Centre, Claudelands, Hamilton.

(Time to be confirmed in Acceptance of Entry)

5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

5.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A and Appendix Three Schedule R of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

5.2 Classes:

Entrants in Top Half Rally Series & others:-

Class A	0 – 1300cc	2WD
Class B	1301 – 1600cc	2WD
Class C	1601 and over	2WD
Class D	Open	4WD
Class E	Pre-2000	4WD*

*Eligible Vehicles: Mitsubishi Evo 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6
Subaru Impreza WRX up to Version 12
And all other 4WD vehicles produced prior to 2000.
Technical rules are as per Schedule A, Appendix Two.
36mm Restrictor.
No sequential or electronically advanced gearboxes.
Dog gearboxes permitted.

NOTE: Competitors can only enter ONE Class

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material.

For those competitors who have not completed remote scrutineering, competitors will present the car for audit scrutineering and for those cars with forced induction engines, restrictor inspection.

Cars will not be cleared to compete until numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

NOTE: YOU MUST BRING YOUR VEHICLE to documentation / scrutineering to allow for Rally Safe to be installed into your vehicle by a RallySafe technician.

Scrutineering Audit:

Rally of Waitomo Leg 1: For the few competitors who have not pre-scrutineered, scrutineering will be held between 5.00pm and 7.00pm, Friday 23rd November at Claudelands Event Centre, Brooklyn Road, Claudelands, Hamilton (Time to be confirmed in Acceptance of Entry)

NOTE: Any competitor who resides in a city where there is a below listed Scrutineer MUST HAVE THEIR VEHICLE REMOTE SCRUTINEERED

7. LIVERY

Each competitor will have in their pack:

2 x Orange numbers for rear windows of rally car

1 x Handy Rentals Hamilton Windscreen Banner

1 x Small number to be placed top left of windscreen of rally car

2 x Handy Rental Door Banners

2 x Service Vehicle numbers to be placed top left windscreen of each service vehicle.

Rally of Waitomo Competitor's numbers start from 51 - 99

Please note that all livery as outlined in these regulations is compulsory.

All competition vehicles must have all the livery as outlined in these regulations in place to gain access to the pre-start area.

8. OFFICIALS IDENTIFICATION

Officials of the event will be identified as detailed below.

- (b) Stage Control (Post) ChiefWill wear Bibs
- (c) ScrutineersName Identification
- (d) Other OfficialsName Identification

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARDS

These will be at any of the following venues:

- Documentation (Claudelands)
- Rally Headquarters
- Results venue

11. RESULTS

Leg 1 - Rally of Waitomo: Provisional results for the event will be posted at – approx.2000hrs at the prizegiving venue at Hamilton Car Clubrooms on Saturday 24th November 2018.

Results will be progressively published on www.chrissport.co.nz

12. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes will be permitted if they are original copies as created for this event and supplied by the MotorSport NZ authorised Provider, Neil Allport Motorsport.

Notes shall be ordered directly from the supplier using the order form on their website
www.namsport.co.nz

These must be ordered by Close of Entries 26th October 2018

Stage notes can be collected at documentation.

NOTE: Silver Fern competitors will be having Stage Note checks on Leg 1 of the Silver Fern Rally.
There will be severe penalties for any Handy Rental Hamilton Rally competitor caught supplying any of the Silver Fern Competitors copies of the supplied notes.

The cost for stage notes is not included in entry fee. Payment for Stage notes is payable directly to Neil Allport Motorsports.

Information:

The stage note system uses an automated computer program to generate a description of the special stage road using sensors fitted to a vehicle driven through each stage.

Such notes describe the route in more detail than the Road Book and can be used without reconnaissance. The purchase and use of the stage notes is a direct contract between the competitor and Neil Allport Motorsport with the organiser's involvement being limited to authorising the use and facilitating the preparation and distribution on behalf of Neil Allport Motorsport.

There is no obligation on any competitor to purchase these stage notes.

13. RECONNAISSANCE

There is **NO** Provision for Reconnaissance on this event.

14. RE- JOINING

The Road book contains a 'Temporary Withdrawal' form, a 'Final Withdrawal' form and a 'Re-joining form'.

No competitor will be permitted to restart the rally if they have handed in a Final Withdrawal form.

If a competitor believes that they may be able to restart after an incident they should complete a 'Temporary Withdrawal' form and hand it to an appropriate official.

If a competitor then wishes to re-join the event they must only do so at the start control of a stage or service or re-group. They must re-join at a time that does not cause any delay to the event.

They must hand in a 'Re-joining form' to the Post Chief.

They must re-join, as close as possible, to their original starting order, if this is not possible then they may be required to proceed to another stage before re-joining.

All cars that have suffered accident damage must be checked and cleared by a scrutineer or designated official before re-joining.

15. CO-ORDINATION OF EVENT BETWEEN EVENTS

Silver Fern Competitors will be given priority at Rally of Waitomo

Silver Fern competitors are competing on their first day of an 8-day marathon rally, and we want to see them get through as many stages as possible of their marathon rally, without being disadvantaged.

Should a Silver Fern Rally vehicle need to be recovered, (and this can be achieved easily and time efficiently), this will be done after the final competing Silver Fern Car has entered the stage.

Handy Rentals Hamilton Rally of Waitomo Rally will follow the last Silver Fern competing car, with a safe and safely managed gap between fields.

16. TROPHIES / CASH PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to Driver and Co-Driver for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Overall Winner
Trophies will be awarded to Driver and Co-driver 1st, 2nd & 3rd Class winners at each Leg

We have \$4000.00, of prizemoney to be shared amongst competitors.

At the end of the event for all competitors who have **STARTED AND FINISHED** Leg 1 Handy Rentals Hamilton Rally of Waitomo, names will be put into a hat where there will be 8 draws of \$500.00.

You have to be present to collect your cash prize. If you are not present there will be a redraw.

17. SERVICING

All service and support vehicles are to be registered with the organisers at the time of entry. They must display throughout the event the official competition numbers and applicable advertising material that will be issued at documentation. Servicing from an unregistered vehicle will be deemed to be the same as servicing in a prohibited area and will be penalised accordingly.

Servicing may be carried out anywhere on a road section except those areas designated in the road book, service book and map as NON-SERVICE areas.

Please ensure Service Numbers are on all service vehicles

NOTE: Service Touring times will be tight between services so some organisation with your service crews will be required.

18. REFUEL

There will be Supplementary Refuels as per below.

Rally of Waitomo Leg 1 Saturday 24th November

Refuel before SS1

Refuel after SS3 – before SS4

19. FINISH OF RALLY

Leg 1 - Rally of Waitomo: Cars will be held in an area on arrival at Hamilton Car Club, until the Clerk of the Course or their delegate release your car.

20. RALLYSAFE

'Rallysafe' tracking and timing technology will be used by all competitors at this event.

An overview of the system which provides significant safety benefits can be found on www.rallysafe.com.au

- a. A 'one off' cost of approximately \$AUD 175.00 plus shipping to purchase the wiring kit, brackets and aerials that can be used at multiple events. These must be ordered from Rallysafe using the online Purchase form found at www.rallysafe.com.au
- b. Rally Safe fee is included in the Entry Fee.
- c. Please make sure that you have ordered and received a wiring kit at least two weeks prior to the event.

21. RALLYSAFE COLLECTION

Leg 1 - Rally of Waitomo: All competitors will be toured back via Claudelands Event Centre to have RallySafe collected from their vehicle, before continuing onto the Hamilton Car Club to the final time control.

22. RECOVERY

Rally of Waitomo Leg 1: There will be two 4 x 4 winch trucks travelling through each stage behind sweeper car that may enable you to get your vehicle back up onto the stage or to the end of the stage at which point you can get your service crew to collect you.

You can negotiate an appropriate fee with them.

GENERAL

A. FUEL

All competitors must use fuel in accordance with Appendix Two Schedule A, Article 3.9 of the current MotorSport Manual.

Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the MotorSport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling. This can be found on the MotorSport NZ website – www.motorsport.org.nz

B. CHANGE OF CO-DRIVER

Due to the nature of the event a Change of Co-driver is only permitted 30 Minutes prior to the start of the Legs.

A replacement Co-driver must complete all Documentation and Scrutineering requirements.

Competitors wishing to take this option must advise the Clerk of the Course via a CRO prior to the start of the Leg.

A Co-driver can then be changed at the start of TCO.

C. PRIZEGIVING & AFTER FUNCTION

Leg 1 - Rally of Waitomo Saturday 24th November

The finish ramp will conclude the finish of the event at the Hamilton Car Club, from here there will be a joint dinner with Silver Fern competitors.

Dinner will be at Hamilton Car Clubrooms starting at approx. 7.30pm.

Following on from dinner there will be a small prizegiving to present Class and Overall Trophies, as well as out cash draws

It will be a late finish for the Handy Rental Rally Competitors, so it is quite ok to have dinner etc, whilst still in your race overalls.

As per last year we will be having a superb Roast spit pork / lamb, ham, vegetables etc.... along with full bar facilities.

Two Meal Tickets are included in your Hamilton Entry ONLY

Additional tickets for the meal are \$40.
