## Round Six Northern Rallysprint Series

Supplementary regulations

### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a Gravel Rallysprint promoted by the **Hamilton Car Club** and will take place on **Sunday 28th July 2019** in the Otorohanga/Maihihi area. This is a Club Sport status event.

The event will run under the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix 3, Schedule RS being the Standing Regulations Governing all Rallysprint Events and Appendix 2, Schedule A - Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements, and any other amendments thereto.

### 3. THE EVENT:

Venue: Hoddle Road, Maihihi, Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2019  
Length: 9 kilometres – Gravel Surface. Approx 14km touring

Reece Run: At 9.30am at Hoddle Road

Drivers Briefing: 9.00am – All drivers must attend drivers briefing at the service park. A roll call will be taken.

Each car will complete a Recce Run and four timed runs. Elimination style results as per normal Northern Rallysprint format will apply; an extra runoff will be used for the top two cars in each class to determine the winner.

If due to force majeure, the runs cannot be completed the appointed Motorsport NZ Steward, after consultation with the Clerk of the Course has the authority to approve the reduction of the minimum requirements. The format that will apply if this happens will be advised prior to the event commencing at drivers briefing.

Hamilton Car Club reserves the right to cancel the event in the event of adverse weather.

#### 4. **ENTRIES**

**Opening:** These open with the publication of these regulations.

**Closing:** Normal entries will close at 5.00pm, Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2019.

**Late Entries:** **Late entries will close at 5:00pm Saturday 27th July 2019 by end of documentation.

In the event of timing equipment failure, or as result of instruction from the Clerk of the Course, a competitor will be allowed a Rerun. Reruns will not be permitted if the timing equipment is displaced or damaged by that competitor.

Dual Driver will be allowed, but please note there will be little to no service time between runs for dual drivers. Please indicate on your entry form if you are a dual driver.

**Acceptance of entry:**

Acceptance of entry will be at the absolute discretion of the organisers. Where more entries than the maximum are received up to the closing of normal entries, late entries will be on a first come first serve basis.

**5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS:**

In signing the entry form competitors (entrant and drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ Inc. National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, in particular the National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations.

- All vehicles must comply with Clause 5 of Schedule 3 Appendix RS
- Rally tyres are permitted.
- Drivers and passengers shall wear safety Apparel as specified in the driver safety regulations contained in Appendix Two Schedule A.
- Drivers must be aware that all passengers must be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness.
- All passengers must sign the passenger indemnity and declaration form prior to their participation.
- The start line will check if the passenger has signed the indemnity and declaration form before allowing the vehicle to start, if the passenger is found not to have signed said indemnity and declaration form then the vehicle will be removed from the start line and this may cause the driver to forfeit this run.
- Minimum age of any passengers is 12 years old.
- Any passengers under 16 years of age must complete a passenger indemnity form at documentation signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the underage passenger for the day)
  
- Driver must hold an M Grade Licence or higher.
- Current Car Club Membership
- If the entrant is other than the driver, an entrant's licence is required in the name of the entrant.
- All cars must have a current wof and rego as touring is on public roads.

All driver(s) must attend the drivers briefing at 9.00am at the service park.

Continue until you get to Maihihi village as you approach you will see a purple shade sail at the Maihihi playcentre.

The road forks left and right, before you get to this take the RIGHT hand road this is Paewhenua Road 1km down this road turn Left into KioKio Sports Club grounds.

**competitors go off in the same section of fence, repair costs will be divided evenly between the parties involved.**

**On release of these regulations any competitor seen travelling the course before the start of the event will be excluded from the event and fined in accordance with Motorsport NZ manual No.36**
